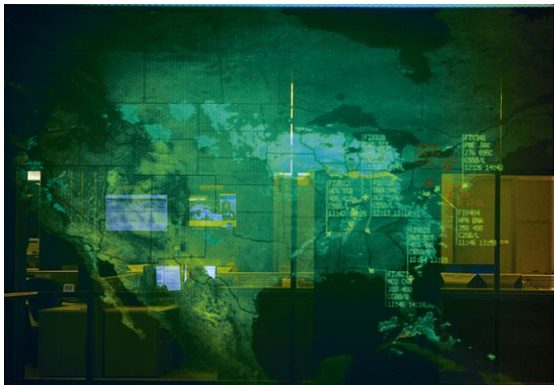
Customers get 50 hours of flying time annually and all of the comforts of a private jet with less cost, no up-keep and the ability to fly in the aircraft best suited to the trip.
